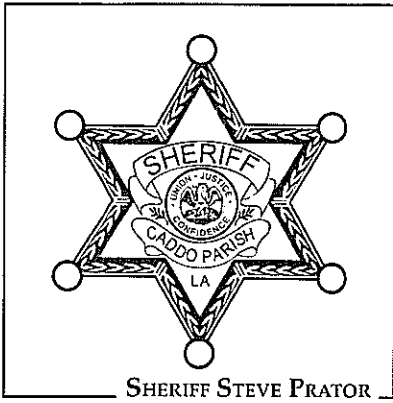

We are in receipt of your public records request dated August 19, 2019. Below is a list of the items you requested and our response:

1. Documents reflecting or showing the number, identity, race, sex, DOB, booking date, charges and bail amount of every pretrial detainee held or housed in your parish jail or detention facilities on August 12, 2019 or the date closest to that date for which you have responsive documents:

Although Caddo Parish Sheriff's Office records the information requested in multiple formats, databases, and files, both electronic and paper, it does not collect, assemble, and record the information in a single document which can be produced as a public record.

2. Documents reflecting or sufficient to show whether any pretrial detainees in your legal custody are in the legal custody of another jurisdiction / are being housed elsewhere, and if so, where they are being housed and who they are, with the specificity requested in request 1 above;\

The current Caddo Correctional Center budget, which relates to the expenses of operating the detention center can be obtained upon payment of the public record fee of \$ 16.00.

6. A document reflecting or indicating what database, electronic management or case management system your office uses to track or log the Parish's incarcerated population.
