Summary of deaths that occurred early in detention or were the result of suicide or homicide in the facility:

- In 2017, one death occurred early in detention and three suicides occurred within a two-month period
- In 2018, one homicide occurred in the facility and one occurred early in detention
- In 2019, two deaths occurred early in detention (one of which was the result of heroin intoxication and the other as a result of meth intoxication) and one suicide

All suicides were hanging by affixing a bed sheet to a window grate inside a one-person cell in an area of the facility that was difficult to monitor
