Morris v. Parish of Sabine(2005)

- Plaintiff accused Detention Center of denial of mental health treatment
- Court ruled that the Plaintiff's complaint frivolous



Sheriff Aaron Mitchell

- Lifelong resident of Sabine Parish
- Elected Sheriff in 2019
- Years of experience in law enforcement
- Maintains an open-door policy for citizens with concerns

Characteristics:

- Capable of housing over 150 male inmates
- Female inmates located on 3^d floor of the Sabine Parish Courthouse (capacity of 30)
- “One of the most modern in the State”
- “We expect the highest standards from our employees and will hold them accountable for their actions”
- Inmate work crew availabilities to provide critical services:
 - Road maintenance
 - Park maintenance
 - Litter control

Death Information:

- Sabine Parish reported that there has been no deaths at their facility from January 1, 2020 – through the present
